Discussion and Recommendations

The candidates were presented in theme batches with a brief background on their nominations. Those that generated debate are highlighted in the minutes.

The candidates are of two broad types, 'open' and 'legacy'. Open candidates require a full assessment of their heritage value for inclusion on the local heritage list.

Legacy refers to those identified as holding adequate heritage value for inclusion on the local heritage list by virtue of a previous assessment by a trusted source, as set out in section 9. of the Technical Guide.

Of the 284 candidates, 261 were recommended for adding to the local heritage list.

Kingsbury Episcopi Parish

The Kingsbury Episcopi history group, known as the 'Kingsbury Time Travellers' submitted an eclectic group of over 40 buildings, structures and local curiosities across the parish. To this were added five legacy candidates by the South West Heritage Trust under section 9 of the Technical Guide, all being identified in the Buildings of Britain series (Pevsner), and four open candidates picked up from the Somerset Historic Environment Record requiring full assessments.

The variety of the nominations reflects the interest of the local community group and includes withy boilers, a bus shelter, a landmark hill, sewer stack pipes and a telephone sign. Kept back from the Kingsbury Time Travellers' list of nominations were several enclosure bridges, as these will be easier to assess with similar bridges from the Somerset Levels and Moors at a future Panel meeting.

The age of the AA sign (HER 29875) at Stembridge was identified as uncertain due to its good condition for its age. The Panel's consensus was to accept the supporting information that it is authentic.

The Thorney Halt railway station (HER 18392) nomination was rejected due to there being no surviving evidence of the platforms or platform shelter, and there is no suggest of an important event or association to merit its inclusion under historical association or social value. Its position is recorded on the Somerset Historic Environment Record.

The Panel requested further evidence to support the nomination of the watermill site at West Lambrook (HER 47018).

The nomination of the village animal pound (HER 47020) highlighted a potential project for a future group of themed candidates.

There was discussion on the merits of the stone arched bridge on Stockditch Road (HER 47031) due to the damage to one of its parapets. This concern was allayed as the parapets of historic bridges are frequently damaged and repaired without overly affecting their historic value if undertaken in a sensitive manner. However, the Panel wished to assess this bridge with the group of other bridges retained for later assessment. The Panel recommended withholding a decision pending further information being brought forward at a future Panel meeting alongside a wider group of early 19th century land enclosure bridges.

The nomination for Porter's apple nursery, Hayes Farm, East Lambrook (HER 47035), generated much debate. The nomination is linked to the nominations for the Old Buffalo Inn, Water Street, East Lambrook (HER 47035) and Hayes Farmhouse, Silver Street, East Lambrook (HER 48170). All relate to the Porter family nursery. The orchard was the site for the development of Porter's Perfection, an important cider apple. Unfortunately, the orchard is no more and there are no distinguishing features to indicate its past orchard use. The Panel felt there was insufficient social and historic interest in the site unless Porter's Perfection could be demonstrated to be a very significant apple to the Somerset cider industry, or for its collective value with Hayes Farm and the Old Buffalo Inn. The latter depending on all the properties being extant and occupied by the Porter family at the relevant time. The Panel recommended its rejection at the meeting but was open to future consideration if the above concerns could be addressed.

The nomination for the 19th century linhay south of Higher Burrow Farm (HER 48175) was triggered by an embedded grist millstone in its rear and roadside wall. The millstone is not sufficient on its own for a nomination but the linhay as a whole would be. Access to the front of the linhay had not been secured so the Panel deemed there to be insufficient information to recommend an addition. Further information is required.

Panel members were impressed by the scale and spread of nominations from the Kingsbury Time Travellers and the group's contribution to the recognition and celebration of local heritage.

Technical Handbook. The nominations cover heritage assets in the parishes of Cloford, Frome, Glastonbury, Street, and Wanstrow.

The increased representation for Street was welcomed.

The Panel agree to three green highway island triangles being rejected due to a lack of heritage interest.

Ruishton and Thornfalcon Neighbourhood Plan

Eight nominations were transferred from the Ruishton and Thornfalcon Neighbourhood Plan 2016-2028 (Made Version 2023). The nominations were included as 'legacy' nominations under section 9 of the Technical Handbook.

The Neighbourhood Plan's identification of local heritage assets is limited to cast iron highway guideposts and letter boxes. The Panel noted that there are many more potential local heritage lists candidates in the parishes. This is a common issue with neighbourhood plan preparation. Highlighting this to neighbourhood plan coordinators is a challenge due to the procedure for their preparation.

Wellington and Rockwell

The nominations for Wellington and Rockwell were the outcome of a project by a University of Exeter second year archaeology student on a 4-week work placement with the SWHT. The student reviewed all the legacy candidates and HER entries in the settlements of Wellington and Rockwell, including visits, and liaised with Wellington Local History & Museum Society for further nominations. The project provided a useful prototype for identifying how future student placements could work and working with volunteers.

The extent of inclusion for the former grounds to Drake's Place (HER 47042) was examined. The grounds retain its ha-ha stonework, pond, part of a brick boundary wall, vintage and clumps of trees, and historic boundaries. The dissected and much cleared area to the north continued to provide an open setting to the remainder of the grounds, holds social value, and has potential for reinstatement. The full extent of the remaining grounds is to be included. It was noted that many of the surviving structures are likely to be curtilage listed with the Grade II Drake's Place, thus would be listed structures set within a local heritage list asset.

The long row of former mill offices and boundary wall along Scott's Lane, (Wellington Trade Court) (HER 32329) are the last buildings to survive from the original site of Fox's woollen mill. Despite the sites limited survival, this range was recognised to be a worthy addition to the list.

The relocation of the early 20th century Bishop Brothers lamppost (part of HER 19556) to the foundry location did not hinder its addition to the list.

The Recreation Ground (HER 18051), adjoining the south-west boundary of Wellington Park, initially appears to be an uninspiring sports field with a sorry looking pitched roofed stone pavilion (with potential). It was gifted by the Fox Family as a

war memorial and has a critical relationship with the Grade II* Registered Park and Garden, which justified its inclusion on the list.

A decision on the leat and mill pond at Westford Mill (HER 31990) was deferred until further information their extent, condition and merits could be provided for a future meeting.

Rockwell Green War Memorial Club (HER 48230) is a converted house of no notable architectural merit. However, it was narrowly deemed worthy of inclusion on the list due to its social and communal value, having been established as a war memorial and in continual use for over 100 years.

Minehead and Alcombe late Victorian and Edwardian villas

A batch of 64 late Victorian and Edwardian villas from the golden period of Minehead's development as a fashionable seaside resort. All except one are 'legacy' candidates from their inclusion in the Conservation Area Appraisal and the Buildings of Britain Series (Pevsner) in line with section 9 of the Technical Guide. The exception being Sherwood, 4 King Edward Road, Minehead (HER 46799), whose threat of garden encroachment initiated the wider study of villas for the period to help with its assessment. The assessment relied on core research by the Minehead Conservation Society.

The transformation of Minehead from a quiet harbour town to a smart resort was achieved from the 1870s to 1930s with the aid of a distinct 'school' of predominantly West Somerset architects. The key architects being James Piers St Aubyn (1815-1895), Charles Henry Samson (1837-1925), Frederick William Roberts (1859-1932), and William John Tamlyn (1870-1933).

Nominations for future Panel Meetings will be required to cover the villas missing as legacy candidates, those of other periods, and all the non-residential buildings.

The Panel hoped the local listing of these villas will help highlight their historic and artistic importance and deter further UPVC window replacements and other inappropriate works.

Cheddar Valley and Yatton Railway

Two public nominations were received for features on the line of the former Cheddar Valley and Yatton Railway (later part of the Cheddar Valley Railway). This prompted an assessment of all the features along the line that lie within the local heritage list area, from the Shute Shelve Tunnel to the former Wells Tucker Street Station.

The line was built as a branch line by the Bristol Exeter Railway. The engineer was John Hingston Fox operating under the direction of his brother Francis Fox. The first sod was cut at Shute Shelve Tunnel in 1867. The line was laid out as a single track. Its structures were built of Mendip conglomerate stone (Draycott marble) and its stations and goods sheds designed in the Bristol and Exeter Railway cottage ornee style.

It opened between Yatton and Cheddar in 1869 and was extended to Wells by 1870. It became known as the 'Strawberry Line' on account of the high volume of local strawberries carried to London and Birmingham. It was also significant for cheese and milk freight and for tourism until its closure to passengers in 1963 and to freight a year later.

The nominations include two bridges to the west of St Leonard's Church, Rodney Stoke (HER 48189). The farm accommodation bridge has been confirmed as extant from the site survey but the former railway bridge over Stoke Brook was shrouded out of view from the footpath by dense vegetation. It was agreed to recommend the addition of the accommodation bridge, but to defer a decision on the bridge over the brook to a future Panel meeting.

The overbridge on Latches Lane, Draycott (HER 48191) is a curiosity as it has a central parapet to subdivide the bridge deck for the road carriageway and a field access link. Further investigation would be worthwhile to determine the rarity of such a bridge.

The local listing recommendation for Shute Shelf Tunnel, Winscombe Hill (HER 48195) covers the south portal and the minor southern length of the tunnel. North Somerset Council will be notified of its inclusion on the local list and encouraged to include the northern section on its list.
