

## Group Visits and Tours

### The Museum

Situated just below Glastonbury Tor the Museum is a unique heritage attraction on the site of the former Abbey Farm.

Here you can explore rural life from the 1800s onwards and discover more about the county's heritage.

The farmhouse and former farm buildings are now home to a series of galleries and exhibition spaces. Outside you will find the farmyard and orchard to explore.

The magnificent 14th-century Abbey Barn is one of the West Country's finest buildings and the centrepiece of the site.

The Museum re-opened in June 2017 following a major £2.4 million redevelopment, led by the South West Heritage Trust.

### Group Tours

Our special discounted rate for group visits includes a complimentary guided tour of the Museum which can be tailored from 30 minutes to one hour.

Our knowledgeable team will guide your group around the galleries explaining the remarkable collections on display. You can also discover more about the Mapstone family who lived and worked at Abbey Farm.

### Payment

### Travel and Parking

The Museum is on the corner of Chilkwell Street and Bere Lane in Glastonbury, Somerset, BA6 8DB.

Free parking for up to 40 cars is available on site. Parking can be reserved for groups.

The Museum is a 10 minute walk from the centre of Glastonbury, Glastonbury Abbey and the base of Glastonbury Tor.

### Access

The Museum offers good access for visitors with disabilities. There are accessible toilets, automatic doors and a lift. There is level access on each floor of the buildings with space to manoeuvre between displays.
