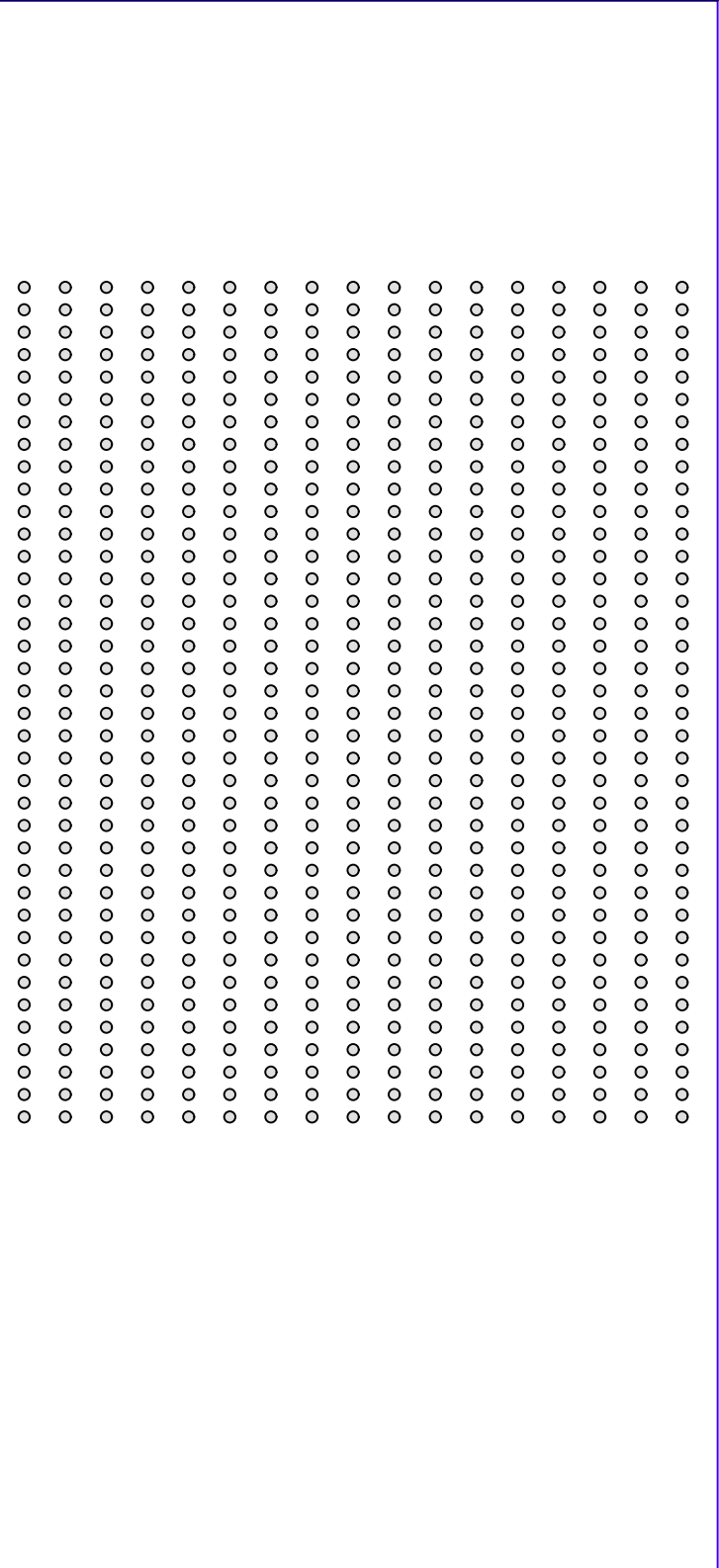


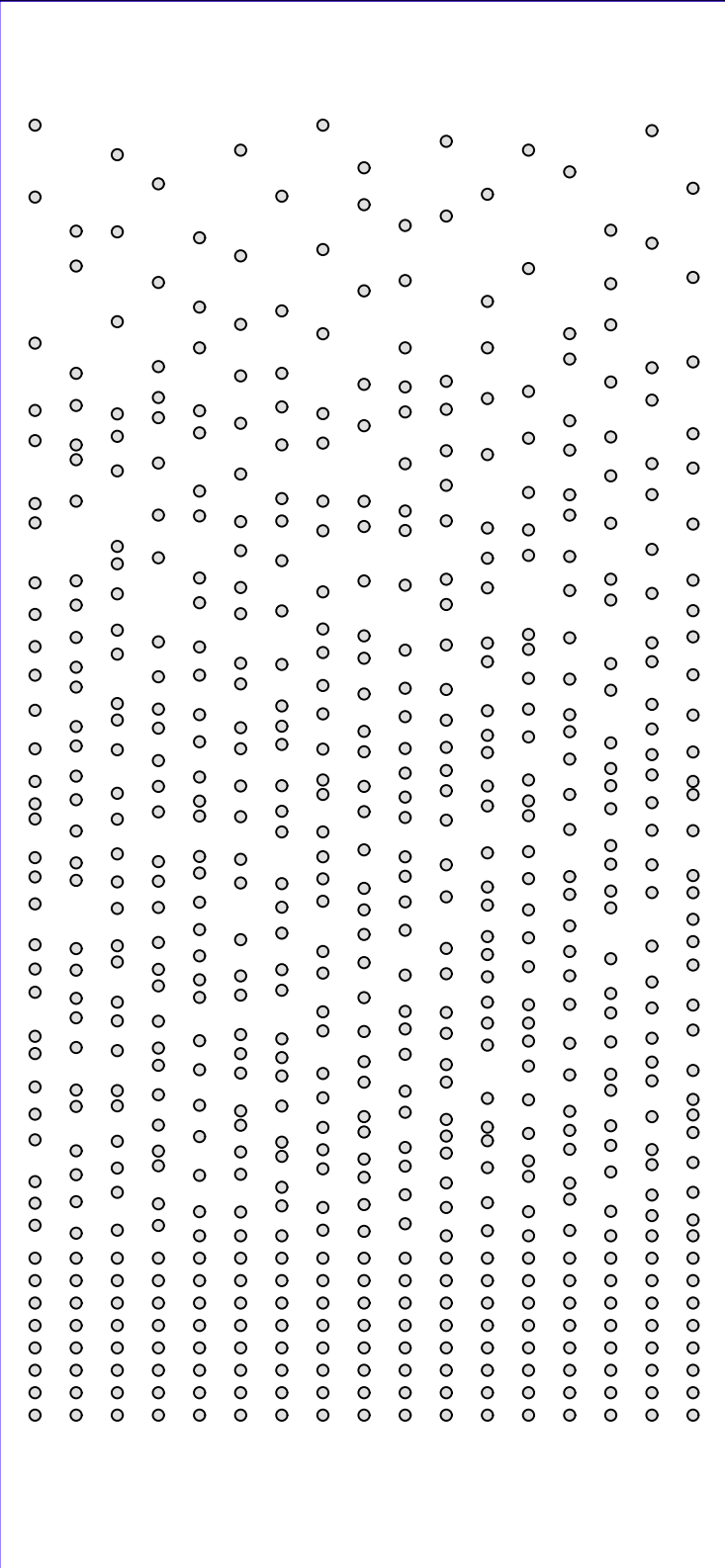
OPTION 1 - ALIGNED

Height (approx.)

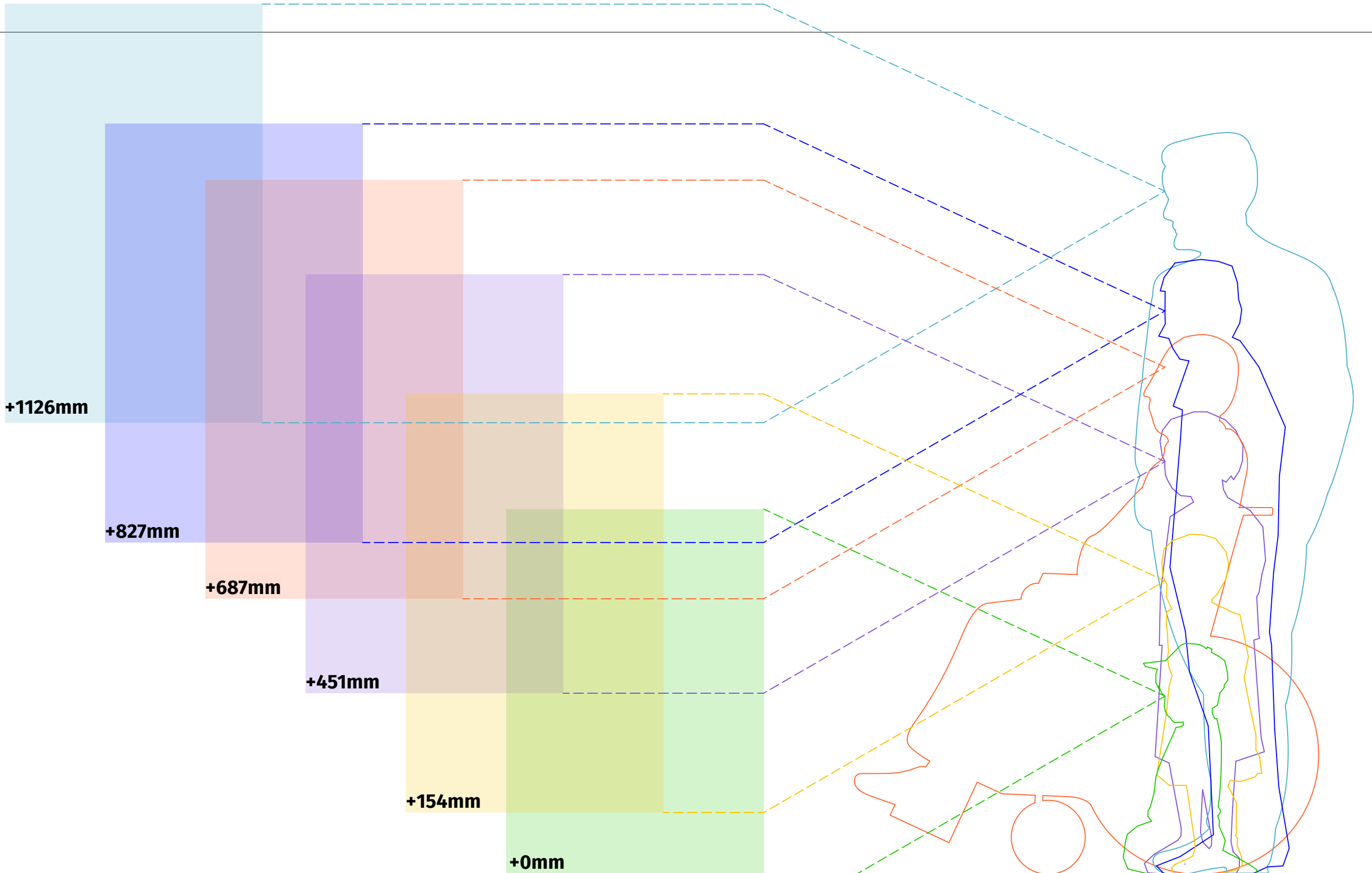
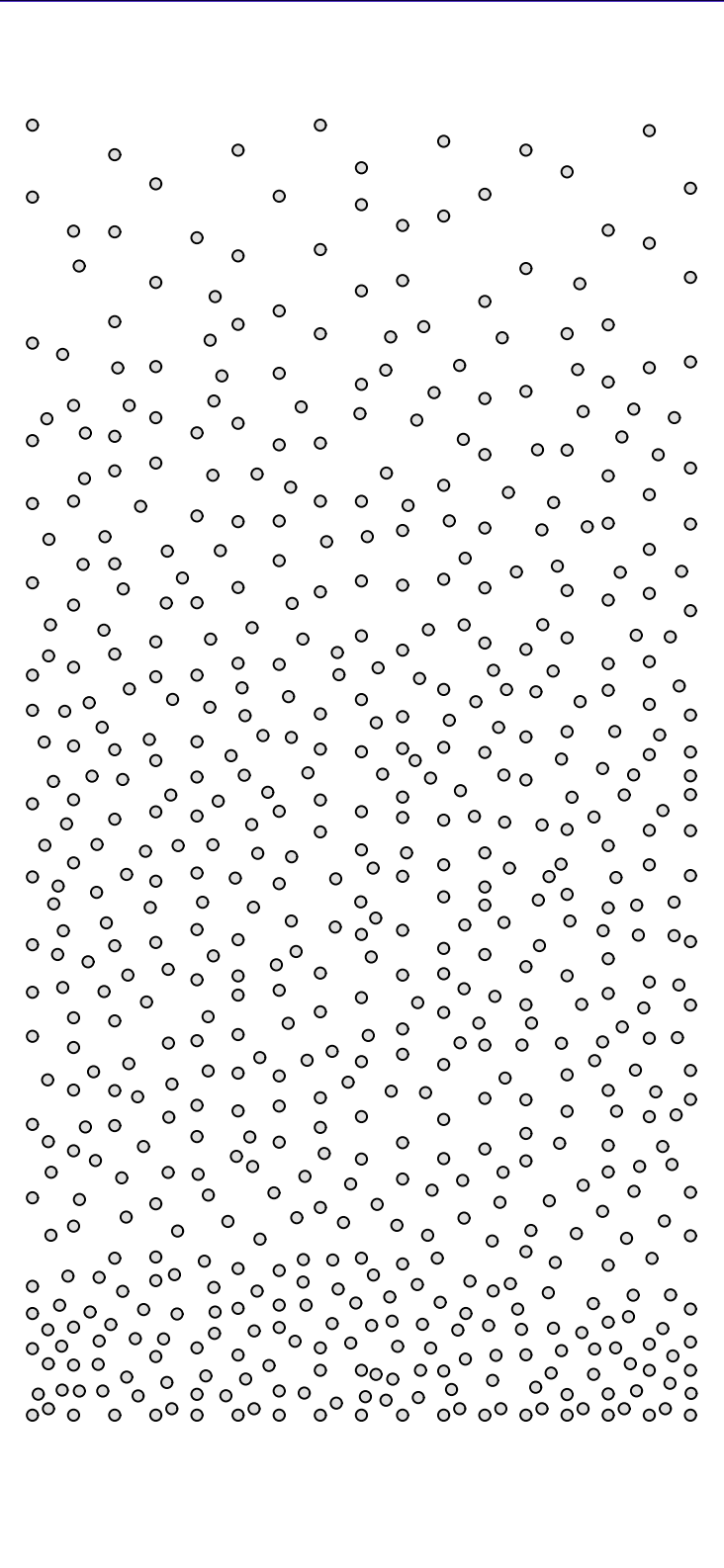


Floor Level

REVISIONS

OBSERVATIONS

- This arrangement allows optimal viewing extents for all age/ability groups, with the exception of crouching children.
- It is very rigid and formal. The coins were found scattered in a field, so this arrangement does not represent the random nature of the hoard.
- This arrangement will not capture the attention of children as well as a more imaginative, random arrangement, as shown in options 2 & 3.

OBSERVATIONS

- This arrangement allows optimal viewing for the groups including Average Child (12 years old) down to Crouching Child - refer to key.
- It is still in vertical lines of coins, but a cascading effect has been introduced, which softens the impact and relates more to the random nature of the hoard.
- With this arrangement being lower to the floor, it is much more accessible for children and wheelchair users.

OBSERVATIONS

- This arrangement allows optimal viewing for the groups including Average Child (12 years old) down to Crouching Child - refer to key.
- This arrangement a fully random cascading effect. The impact is soft on the eyes and gives a good impression of how the hoard was strewn across the field.
- With this arrangement being lower to the floor, it is much more accessible for children and wheelchair users.
